Radioactive Material, Excepted Package (UN2908, UN2909, UN2910, UN2911)

[10.5.8.2.1; 10.5.8.2.2]:

1. If **international shipments** (Form 400 series), ensure GSRG/eSRG shows "D" designation .
2. If **023 air waybills**, correct statement(s) in the Handling Information box, as appropriate. [10.8.8.1] Shipper address on Declaration must include country.
3. Complies with all applicable **government and FedEx variations**. [FX-03]
4. If **going to HI and AK**, ensure shipment is acceptable to destination per GSRG / eSRG.
5. **Shipper and consignee** name and address are marked on the package. [10.7.1.3.2]
6. **Radioactive Material, Excepted Package label** is on the package. [10.7.4.4.3.1.]
7. **UN number**, is marked on the label. [10.7.1.3.2; 10.7.4.4.3.1]
8. **Gross weight** of the package (in metric units) is marked **if the package exceeds 50 kg** (110 lb). [10.7.1.3.1]

If RQ and Radioactive Material, Excepted Package (UN2908, UN2909, UN2910, UN2911):

The following must be on the Declaration and package:

9. **UN number**, preceded by prefix "UN", is on the Declaration. [10.8.3.9.1, Step 1]
- 10a. **Proper shipping name** is on the Declaration. [10.8.3.9.1, Step 2]
- 10b. **Proper shipping name** is marked on the package. [10.7.1.3.1]
11. **Shipper and consignee** name and address on the Declaration. May differ from that on the airbill. [10.8.3.1; 10.8.3.2]
12. **"RQ"** must be on the Declaration before or after the basic description (e.g., RQ UN2910 Radioactive Material, Excepted Package - Limited Quantity of Material, 7; **or**, UN2910 Radioactive Material, Excepted Package - Limited Quantity of Material, 7, RQ). [USG-04]
- 13a. If **overpacked**, the words **"overpack used"** must be on the Declaration. [10.8.3.9.2 Step 8]
- 13b. If **overpacked**, the word **"Overpack"** marked on the package if all markings and labels are not visible. [10.7.1.4.1]

If RQ and UN2908, UN2909, UN2911

On the Declaration Only:

Tracking number, airport/city of departure, and destination may be completed by the shipper or the Dangerous Goods Specialist. There must be at least 3 copies in English. 2 copies must have red hatchings. [FX-14]

14. **Typewritten or computer-generated**. [FX-12]
15. **Page of Pages**. [10.8.3.4]
16. **Passenger and Cargo Aircraft** limitations correctly indicated. Medical or research certification not required. [10.8.3.5;]
17. **Non-radioactive deleted**. [10.8.3.8]
18. **Class number 7** [10.8.3.9.1, Step 3]
19. **Name or symbol of radionuclide(s)** (e.g., Ir-192, Mo-99). [10.8.3.9.2, Step 6 (a)]
20. **Activity of radionuclide(s)** in Becquerels (e.g., Bq, MBq, GBq, TBq, etc). [10.8.3.9.2, Step 7]
21. **Number of packages and type of packaging** (e.g., 1 Excepted Package) [10.8.3.9.2, Step 7]
22. **Description of the physical and chemical form** (e.g., liquid sodium iodide, solid metal, etc.) or "Special Form" (if not already included in Proper Shipping Name). [10.8.3.9.2, Step 6 (b)]
23. **Name, title, place, date, and shipper's signature** on the Declaration. [10.8.3.13; 10.8.3.14; 10.8.3.15]
24. **24-hour emergency response telephone number** indicated on the declaration (no beepers or pagers). [USG-12]

If RQ and UN2910

On the Declaration Only:

Tracking number, airport/city of departure, and destination may be completed by the shipper or the Dangerous Goods Specialist. There must be at least 3 copies in English. 2 copies must have red hatchings. [FX-14]

25. **Typewritten or computer-generated**. [FX-12]
26. **Page of Pages**. [10.8.3.4]
27. **Non-radioactive deleted** [10.8.3.8]
28. **Class number 7** [10.8.3.9.1, Step 3]
29. **Activity of radionuclide(s)** in Becquerels (e.g., Bq, MBq, GBq, TBq, etc) on the Declaration [10.8.3.9.2, Step 7]
30. **24-hour emergency response telephone number** indicated on the declaration (no beepers or pagers). [USG-12]
31. **Name, title, place, date, and shipper's signature** on the Declaration. [10.8.3.13; 10.8.3.14; 10.8.3.15]

Packages Containing Dry Ice:

32. All dry ice marking, labeling, and documentation entries complied with. [Packing Instruction 904; 7.1.5.1; 8.2.4]
